Show Publication and Registrations

1) The organizer mandates Animal Projects to collect registrations for the show(s) through its online website at www.onlinedogshows.eu.

The organizer will complete and validate all pricings, dates, texts and documents before publication of the show(s) on the www.onlinedogshows.eu website. Animal Projects declines all responsibility related to the publication of wrong prices, dates or information.

The organizer offers registrations to the show(s) through the OnlineDogShows platform at a price no higher than on alternative registration channels.

The organizer guarantees to exhibitors registered through the OnlineDogShows platform the same rights and benefits as exhibitors registered through any other channel.

2) To collect registration fees, the organizer mandates Animal Projects to open on behalf of the organizer one or more *electronic money accounts*, also known as e-wallets, with MANGOPAY SA, 10 Boulevard Royal, L-2449 Luxembourg, listed under Number B173459 on the Luxembourg Trade and Company Register, approved as an electronic money institution by the Financial Sector Regulator (CSSF).

The organizer will provide all documents requested by MANGOPAY to perform KYC (“Know Your Customer”) validation and UBO (“Ultimate Beneficiary Owners”) verifications according to legal obligations related to MANGOPAY’s license as an electronic money issuer as part of measures to counter fraud, money laundering and financing of terrorism.

The organizer has received a copy and accepts the MANGOPAY Payment Service Framework Agreement General Terms and Conditions.

Animal Projects can process incoming payments on the onlinedogshows.eu website through any of the following payment service providers: MANGOPAY, MULTISAFEPAY (www.multisafepay.com) and PAYPAL (www.paypal.com). Animal Projects chooses which payment service provider to use based on chosen payment method, currency, service availability and financial criteria.

3) Animal Projects will transfer the collected registration fees lowered with the OnlineDogShows registration platform fee, on an e-wallet of the organizer as soon as payment is received and identified.

The OnlineDogShows registration platform fee is due for each incoming payment regardless of a future refund or chargeback.

The OnlineDogShows registration platform fee covers publication of the show(s) on the website www.onlinedogshows.eu, collection of registrations through the website including financial transaction costs and advertising the show(s) through regular marketing emails.

4) Animal Projects will perform payouts of the e-wallets to an IBAN account once a week or on demand during the registration period up to two times without additional charges and provided the wallet holds at least 5.000 €. In addition, Animal Projects will perform a payout of the remaining balance of the wallet once the registration period is closed and the organizer confirms no further payments are refunds are expected.

5) Animal Projects may also use directly integrated Payment Service Providers without segregated e-wallet account. In this case funds are kept by Animal Projects on a shared 3rd parties account until transferred to the IBAN account of the organization. Transfer costs are at charge of the organization.

6) A chargeback is a demand by a credit-card provider for a retailer to make good the loss on a fraudulent or disputed transaction.

Both Animal Projects and the organizer will try to limit the number of chargebacks by taking adequate security measures and providing correct information. However, in case a chargeback occurs, Animal Projects will first invite the registrant to repay the charged amount. If the registrant fails to repay the charged amount in due time, Animal Projects will inform the organization of the chargeback. At any time, the organisation can also ask for a list of chargebacks that occurred.

Any charged back amount will be debited from the shows e-wallet or, if the wallet has insufficient funds, will have to be reimbursed by the organization to Animal Projects.

Note that chargebacks can occur up to 13 months after the initial payment.

7) Registrations are automatically closed at a predetermined date and time validated by the organizer. Animal Projects advises the organizer to foresee the ability to extend the registration period with at least 48h, for instance to cover an exceptional downtime of the OnlineDogShows registration platform near the registration deadline.

8) All data related to the registrants, the dogs and their owners collected through the OnlineDogShows registration platform can be used both by Animal Projects to ease registration in other shows, to inform about other shows or about OnlineDogShows platform news, as well as by the organiser to realize the shows), to publish in the catalog(s), and to inform about future events of the organizer provided acceptance by the registrant and in full accordance to privacy regulations in Belgium and in the organizers country.

9) Fees are collected in EUR. Only after explicit agreement and verification of the support provided by the whole financial chain can we open registrations in one additional currency.

Show Preparation

10) Once registrations to the show(s) are closed, and after explicit notification of the organizer that all registration data has been validated and is ready to be used for document generation, Animal Projects will generate the body (inside content pages excluding cover, additional texts, advertisements, etc.) of a PDF catalog suited for print and well as documents for the showground based on the OnlineDogShows templates for the show's country.

The organizer has received a sample set of documents generated with the OnlineDogShows templates for his country as well as a sample PDF catalog body.

All generated documents will contain an OnlineDogShows logo which may not be removed.

Please note that the generation of the documents may take up to 48 hours.

11) After closing the registrations to the show(s), Animal Projects will also send entry cards by email to all registrants.

Digital Show Experience

12) Organizers choosing the digital show experience can rent scanners, software to scan entry cards and vouchers (only for cacib shows), tablets, software to record contest results and WIFI-routers

All devices are delivered with pre-installed and pre-configured software, ready to use.

When written judgment reports must be recorded, Animal Projects also offers keyboards for rental.

If using digital show experience, the organizer must provide a WIFI network of which SSID and password will be determined by Animal Projects. All scanners and tablets will be preconfigured with for WIFI network.

WIFI-routers rented at Animal Projects are for the sole purpose of providing internet access by the tablets and scanners of Animal Projects and may not be used for public internet access or other uses.

The organizer must store the rented hardware securely and have an insurance covering theft, loss and accidental damage of the rented hardware.

All rentals must be requested at least 2 months before the first day of the show(s). Rental fees will be due for all requested rentals not cancelled 2 months before the first day of the show.

13) Contest results recorded by the tablets are published real-time on the site www.onlinedogshows.eu. After the show, an Excel document is generated with all results and handed to the organizer.

14) Though Animal Projects puts a lot of effort in developing flawless and robust result recording applications, defects or information loss are never to exclude. Animal Projects therefore strongly advises organizers to have a 'backup plan', i.e. under the form of recording results on paper, and to keep this backup for at least 1 year after the show.

15) A limited online mobile-friendly version of the show catalog can also be made available on the website www.onlinedogshows.eu.

16) When using digital show experience facilities, Animal Projects advises the organizer to offer a free WIFI access to the visitors so they can access online results and/or the online catalog without extra data/roaming costs.

17) Photographs made in relation to show results (BOB and/or main ring winners) can be published on the www.onlinedogshows.eu result pages free of charge provided they bear the OnlineDogShows.eu logo.

Animal Projects preferred partner for show photography is KYNOWEB. We will be pleased to request them for a quote.

Result titling for main ring winners can be added to live streaming feeds free of charge provided OnlineDogShows.eu is mentioned as media sponsor.

Animal Projects preferred partner for live streaming is ALDAHIRUS. We will be pleased to request them for a quote.

18) To assist in the organization of the show(s) using digital show experience, Animal Projects can provide a limited staff dedicated to assisting in the operation of the rented hardware, software and registration services of the show secretary.

All travel expenses, overnights, parking costs and meals of the Animal Projects staff are at charge of the organizer. As those costs depend on the residence of the proposed staff members, Animal Projects will inform the organizer of the expected costs before confirming the staff reservation.

All staff reservations must be requested 3 months before the first day of the show(s). In case of cancellation of part or entirety of the staff, already made travel expenses will be due by the organizer. Also, in case of cancellation of part or entirety of the staff within 2 months before the first day of the show(s), a cancellation fee of 50% of the staff cost will be due.

Miscellaneous

19) Animal Projects offers a secured online backoffice to the OnlineDogShows registration platform for the organizer to use. This backoffice offers at least the following capabilities: updating show definition data (published texts and documents, real-time consultation of registrations, editing registrations to fix most common registration errors, statistics about registrations, download of all registration data in CSV format, editing ring definitions.

The features and capabilities of this platform will increase over time.

Once a capability is available on the backoffice for the organizer to use in self-service mode and Animal Projects has informed the organizer of this, Animal Projects may charge service fees to the organizer to execute those capabilities on his behalf.

20) Customizations either on the registration system, the backoffice, the tablet apps, the generated documents or any other part of the service offered by Animal Projects should be requested in due time.

Animal Projects will provide a best-effort in realizing the requested customizations but may charge development cost or may decline the request based on technical or planning/capacity arguments.

21) Animal Projects provides services for the organization of dogshows and as such can only be liable for the part of the services it offers. Its liability is limited to the fees and retributions it earns on the given show(s), excluding staff expenses and material transportation costs.

22) Nor Animal Projects nor the organizer shall be held liable in the event of delayed or non-execution when the cause is related to a case of force majeure as defined by the jurisprudence of Belgian courts.

23) This agreement is subject to the Belgian law and any dispute between parties under the current agreement will be subject to the jurisdiction of competent Belgian courts.

24) If any of the provisions of this agreement are considered invalid or unenforceable, the shall be deemed unwritten and shall not affect or invalidate the remaining provisions.

25) In the event of cancellation of the exhibition for whatever reason, the costs of reimbursement to the exhibitor will be fully charged to the organization.
